


# Boat Launch locations in the Village of Winneconne

## **Facts**

Many communities in Winnebago County have enacted a Boat Trailer Parking Permit Program. In 2005, the Village of Winneconne enacted a similar program. The program was initiated in the Village to provide an additional funding source for maintaining and improving the quality of our boat launching facilities. With the acquisition of Lake Winneconne Park from the Winnebago County Parks System in January 2005, the Village now possesses two launching sites, one at Lake Winneconne Park and one on North First Street.

## **Separate stickers for local municipalities**

Each municipality requires a separate sticker for their respectively owned launch site (s), including a separate sticker for County owned launches.

## **Additional permits**

When purchasing your initial parking permit sticker, you may purchase, for a fee, a second or subsequent sticker for any additional vehicles you may own and use for launching your boat. Proof of ownership is required. In the event that the original vehicle that has the parking sticker affixed is sold, a new sticker can be obtained free of charge by bringing the old sticker to the Winneconne Municipal Center.

## **Boat Trailer sticker location**

By designating this as a boat trailer Parking Permit involving a sticker attached to a motor vehicle, it empowers the Village to apply enforcement through state statute 345.28. This statute cannot be used for a program where the permit and sticker are linked only to a boat trailer. It is solely used through state statute 345.28 that the vehicle license plate number can be legitimately used and a citation issued.

If the Permit and sticker were to be linked to the boat trailer alone, it undermines the Village's right to designate the owner of the motor vehicle as the violator. Further, since there is no vehicle license plate number required for most boat trailers, the ability to enforce the Boat trailer Parking Permit is compromised and perhaps impossible when the trailer owner and vehicle owner are not the same.

## **Placement of the Parking Permit sticker**

Permanently affix the Permit sticker to the lower corner of the interior of the windshield on the driver's side of the towing vehicle.
