NOTIFY ME is a new way of getting all the latest news, alerts, calendars and agendas from the Village. You will find the “notify me” button on our new website winneconne.wi.gov. It’s fast and easy and you have the chance to pick and choose what news and alerts you want to receive. You also get to choose whether you want emails or texts or both. Visit our new website today. You can also download the Winneconne app on your smartphone from Google Play Store or The App Store.

Dog Licenses are due March 31, 2017: The Village is using new software for licensing your dog. Your dog’s rabies shot information may not have transferred over, therefore everyone will have to bring proof of rabies shot from your veterinarian when you register your dog. The cost is \$10.00 per dog or \$5.00 per neutered/spayed dog. Proof of rabies is required. Avoid a \$92.50 citation from the Police Department and a late fee of \$5.00 by registering your dog before March 31, 2017.



LOTTERY CREDIT: You may claim the lottery and gaming credit if, on January 1, 2016 you were the owner of the property and used the property as your primary residence. If you qualify, please check your tax bill carefully to make sure you received the lottery credit. If you have any questions, contact the Village office.

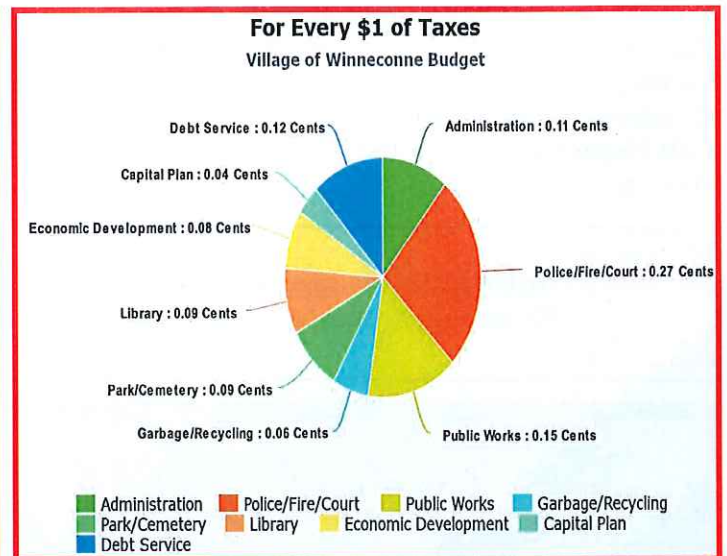
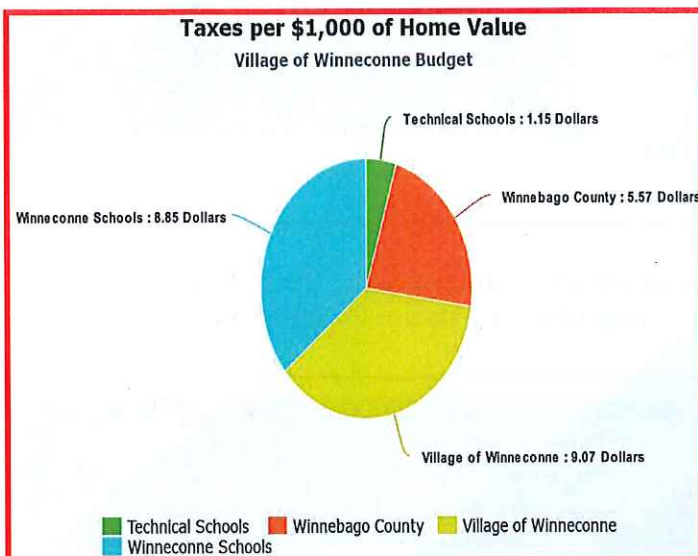
TAX PAYMENTS: There are three ways you can accomplish this!

- Drop box:** A black drop box is located on the west side of the Municipal Building.

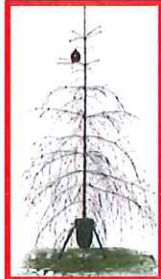

Winter parking restrictions are in effect November thru March

Adopt a hydrant this winter by shoveling around any hydrant located near your home. Sidewalks need to be cleared of all snow and ice within 24 hours of the end of a snow event. Remember placement of any snow or ice into the public street or alley of the Village is a violation of our ordinance.



Compost Site: The site will be open January 3rd thru 6th between the hours of 8 am and 3 pm for disposal of your Christmas tree. The compost site will reopen for the season on April 1st and operate Saturdays 9 am until 2 pm and Wednesdays 12 pm until 7 pm (or dusk whichever comes first). There is a \$5.00 fee for an annual compost site sticker. Stickers can be purchased at the Village Hall and they are for Village residents only.

Spring Clean-up Days: April 3rd thru 7th, (Mon., Tues., Thurs. & Fri. 8 am until 3 pm; Wed. 8 am until 7 pm and Sat. 9 am until 2 pm)

Park Shelter Rentals: Making wedding plans? Going to have a family reunion, birthday party or baby shower? Why not rent a Winneconne park shelter? We are now taking reservations for the 2017 and 2018 season and dates are filling fast. The park shelters are available from the middle of May until the middle of October. New Garbage Receptacles Place your receptacles on your driveway apron or terrace so that they are 3 feet away from each other and 3 feet away from parked cars, mail boxes and other obstructions. Always place your receptacles so that the white id numbers are facing the street. **Winter placement** of your carts is best on your driveway apron after you have cleared it of snow. **DO NOT** place your receptacles on top of a snow bank, in the street or on the sidewalk. Improperly placed receptacles will not be collected. Please have your receptacles out by 6:00 AM on the day of pick-up. If you have any questions, please call Advanced Disposal 920-685-6666.

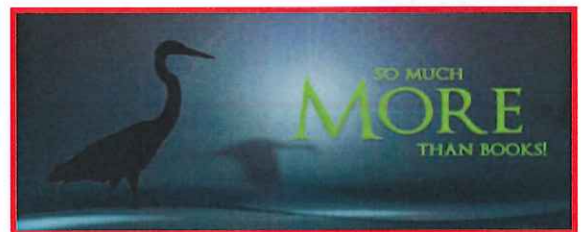
