ACCEPT

ALL plastic bottles, cups & containers

- Household bottles, jars & jugs
- Dairy containers & lids
- Deli, bakery & produce containers & lids

DO NOT ACCEPT

- Plastic bags, wrap or film
- Motor oil bottles
- Styrofoam



Empty, rinse and replace caps & lids.

Metal

ACCEPT

- Aluminum bottles & cans
- Steel & tin cans
- Empty aerosol cans

DO NOT ACCEPT

- Aluminum pans or foil
- Empty paint cans
- Large/bulky scrap metal

Empty and rinse food cans. No need to remove labels.

Recycling Guidelines



Place all recyclables in your curbside collection bin loosely. Keep plastic bags, food, clothing and other household garbage out of your recycling bin.

Place shredded paper in a paper bag and staple shut. Flatten and cut boxes to 2 ft x 2 ft or smaller.
