

Wastewater Treatment Fees

Generally all water service connections will be required to pay for wastewater disposal. Fixed rates are charged quarterly by size of water meter.

Usage rate is based on the gallons treated. A fee of \$12.02 per thousand gallons of water metered.





Are Water Leaks Costing You

- Check all faucets for drips
- Check Toilets for leaks
- Check outside faucets to make sure they are turn all the way off



▲ dripping leak consumes:
15 gal. per day
450 gal. per month
1,350 GALLONS PER QUARTER



▲ 1/32 in. leak consumes:
264 gal. per day
7,920 gal. per month
23,760 GALLONS PER QUARTER



▲ 1/16 in. leak consumes:
943 gal. per day
28,300 gal. per month
84,900 GALLONS PER QUARTER



▲ 1/8 in. leak consumes:
3,806 gal. per day
114,200 gal. per month
342,600 GALLONS PER QUARTER

Mission Statement

The Village of Winneconne provides locally owned water and sewer services for its residents. The services are funded by the user fees.

Water

- To provide clean drinking water for public consumption while providing adequate volume and pressure for public and private fire protection.
- To begin and sustain the replacement and upgrade of the water system infrastructure.
- To provide the above services at a price affordable to the customer.

Wastewater

- To upgrade the wastewater treatment plant so it can perform its regulated purpose for the next 20 years.
- To begin and sustain the upgrade of the sewer collection system and to reduce treatment costs by reducing infiltration and inflow.
- To plan and implement these improvements in a timely, orderly fashion.

DEDUCT METERS



- A deduct meter is an additional meter used to monitor the amount of water which does not go into the Sanitary Sewer System. By monitoring this usage and deducting it from the sanitary sewer portion of the utility bill a reduction in cost is obtained. Generally this water is used outside the home for watering lawns, plants and shrubs.
- All new deduct meters shall be "plumbed in" at the home. An annual fee applies.

Fire Protection

Fees associated with fire protections are also charged as part of your utility bill.

Costs are included in this bill to maintain and operate fire fighting protection. A service charge is applied as follows:

Billing Information

Quarterly Billing Fees

A provision for Private Fire Protection is provided at a rate of \$327.00 for an 8" service line.

Bills for services are rendered quarterly. There is a 3% quarterly late fee.

Unpaid bills as of November 1st will be added to the tax roll with an additional 10% penalty.
