

Public Safety Committee

Minutes

December 9, 2024, 4:30pm

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:30pm by Chairman Bouras. Present were, Trustee Kubasta, Trustee Stelzner, and Chief Sauriol.

Approval of the November 11th, 2024, PSC meeting minutes.

Communications:

Chief Sauriol stated the new squads were delayed in the factory and the new build date(s) are December 14th and 15th.

Old Business:

Chief Sauriol updated the committee on the new body cameras from Lenslock. Chief Sauriol stated they are working well, and the system has improved data retention and allows for proper open record requests and redactions. Trustee Kubasta asked what the cost is per year. Chief Sauriol stated it's a 5-year contract at \$4300 a year which includes unlimited cloud storage, free redaction services, and replacement of the cameras every 30 months. Chief Sauriol stated if a camera should break or fail for any reason, Lenslock will overnight a new camera as part of the contract at no cost.

Chief Sauriol stated the FY24 budget is coming close to the end and as of December 9th, 2024, the budget is at 95% and on track to finish plus or minus 5% of what was budgeted.

New Business

Chief Sauriol discussed with the committee the November 2024 police stats. Chief Sauriol explained what community policing calls mean, discussed what a traffic safety call is and went over the general activity for the month of November. Chief Sauriol stated the police department's activity has been steady and higher than last month and this time last year. Chief

Sauriol gave credit to the officers for working hard to stay visible within the community and continuing to be active.
